## **Enterra to open Iraq office**

Enterra Solutions LLC is opening an office in the Kurdish region of Iraq so it can help factories establish supply-chain logistics.

The private management consulting company, which is based in Yardley, Pa., but has a growing presence in Reston, is working with the local government in Erbil, Iraq, to help develop the area socially and economically.

The office opening is also a strategic move for Enterra as it seeks to win more work with the U.S. Departments of Defense and State as well as the Iraqi Central Government, the Kurdistan regional government and companies in the region.

Enterra hires software engineers who are experts in industries such as telecommunications and financial services to help emerging markets build infrastructure and attract foreign direct investment.

The company's newest office, in the Erbil Convention Center, will be able to hold up to 50 employees.

Enterra moved its Washington office from Vienna to Reston in April so it would have more space for its increasing numbers of employees. Since March, the company has nearly doubled its Washington area employees to 25.

The Erbil office is the Enterra's third, but it plans to expand throughout the Middle East, Central Asia and Africa.
